

AIHE 2022 International Student Support Scholarship

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Scholarship Summary

The scholarship is designed to provide financial assistance to students due to the global economic impact resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic. There are no additional academic terms and conditions specific to the scholarship.

Value

The Scholarship rewards successful applicants with a 30% tuition fee reduction. The scholarship applies to all subjects studied for the relevant course.

Eligibility

This scholarship is available to all new international students enrolling in any Adelaide Institute of Higher Education (AIHE) course in 2022. There are no caps applied to the scholarship.

Exclusions

As per terms and conditions provided in table below.

Application process

There will be no separate application form applied for the scholarship, as this is a one-off scholarship offering for 2022 in response to the current COVID-19 situation and the scholarship will be automatically applied to all eligible applicants.

Continuing eligibility conditions and delivery of scholarship

Scholarship Name	The AIHE 2022 International Student Support Scholarship
Scholarship Value	The scholarship provides a 30% reduction in tuition fees for all subjects enrolled in the student's course.
Scholarship Duration	Full course duration.
Number of Scholarships	No cap. The scholarship will be applied to any new students commencing in 2022.
Delivery of scholarship	Scholarship payments (30% of tuition fees) will be provided as a tuition fee waiver. The amount will be deducted from the student's contribution invoice (tuition fee) at the commencement of each applicable study period of the course.
	The scholarship does not cover the costs of visas, Overseas Student Health Cover, travel, accommodation, living expenses, books and study materials or any other expenses associated with living in Adelaide or study at the Adelaide Institute of Higher Education.
Scholarship conditions	 This Scholarship is available to international students commencing in their course of study at AIHE in 2022. The Applicant must be eligible to study in Australia. The Applicant must meet the entry requirements for the relevant course.



2022 International Student Support Scholarship TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Recipients will be selected based on the published selection/eligibility criteria for the scholarship. Selection is undertaken in accordance with the Scholarship Terms and Conditions.
- 5. The following students are not eligible to receive this Scholarship:
 - a. Australian citizens or permanent residents of Australia;
 - b. Current AIHE students; and
 - c. Students who are recipients of a scholarship awarded by a recognised scholarship awarding body such as a government ministry or department.
- 6. This Scholarship is not paid for subjects where credit is granted in recognition of prior learning/study.
- 7. This Scholarship is not is not transferable to a third party or redeemable for cash.
- 8. This Scholarship cannot be deferred to a subsequent year.
- The Scholarship recipient is required to enrol in their respective AIHE course as an international student and must maintain their enrolment in the study periods where the Scholarship has been awarded.
- 10. This Scholarship will be terminated if the recipient ceases to be an international student (i.e. no longer eligible under condition 6.a. above).
- 11. An onshore Scholarship recipient is required to enrol in a full-time study load for each study period where the Scholarship applies,
- 12. The Terms and Conditions applicable to payment of fees do not change with the awarding of this Scholarship.
- 13. The Scholarship recipient must pay their tuition fees within the stipulated payment deadlines.
- 14. If the Scholarship recipient enrols in subjects at another institution, including cross-institutional study, those tuition fees are not covered by this Scholarship.
- 15. If the Scholarship recipient is required to repeat a subject, the student is liable to pay for the tuition fees for the repeated subject.
- 16. The Scholarship recipient agrees to notify AIHE immediately if they intend to:
 - a. Discontinue study with AIHE;
 - b. Transfer to another institution;
 - c. Withdrawal from any courses they have enrolled in; or
 - d. Defer their studies and/or apply for Approved Leave.
- 17. AIHE reserves the right to vary the award, withdraw or discontinue this Scholarship if:
 - a. the Scholarship recipient has not achieved or ceases to meet the eligibility requirements of this Scholarship; or
 - b. the Scholarship recipient is found to have supplied incorrect or misleading information during the application process; or
 - the Scholarship recipient fails to maintain good academic standing and progress;
 or
 - d. there is a case of serious misconduct by the Scholarship recipient; or
 - in any other case where AIHE determines that the Scholarship eligibility requirements have not been met or maintained.
- 18. The Scholarship recipient may be asked to participate in activities for the promotion of this Scholarship and AIHE and must willing to be featured in promotional collateral produced by AIHE.
