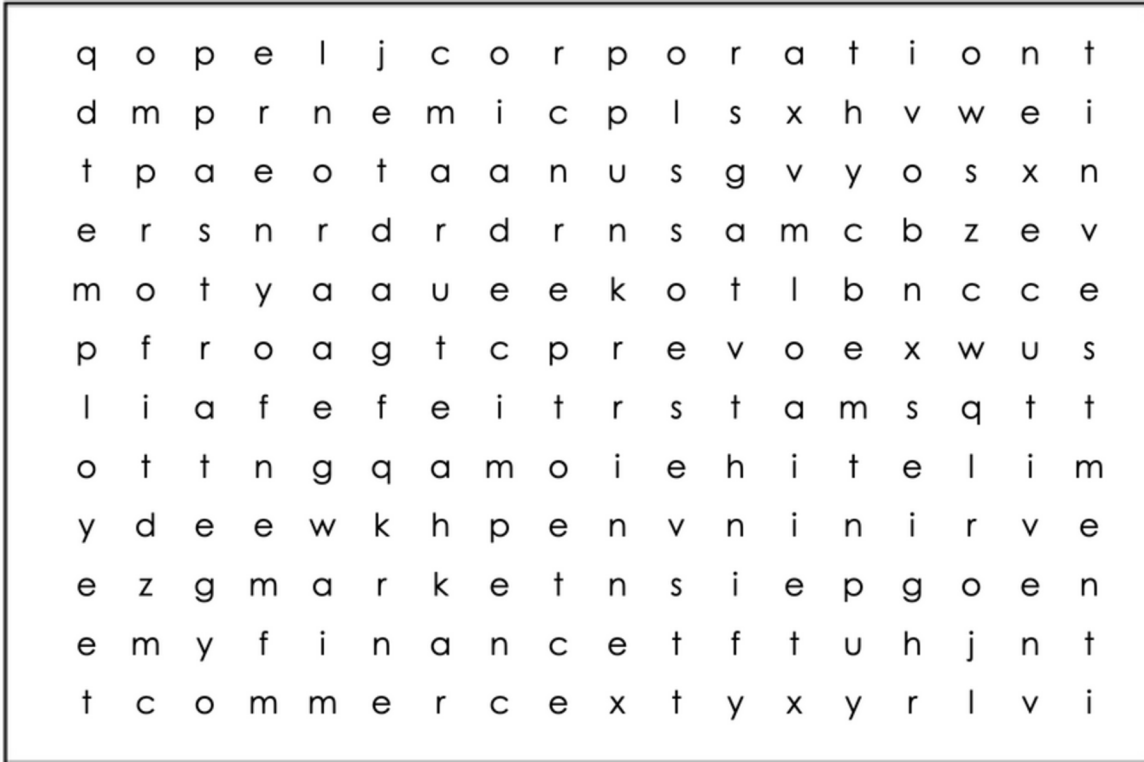


**(2)** Draw lines to connect the numbers without going outside the box or crossing lines

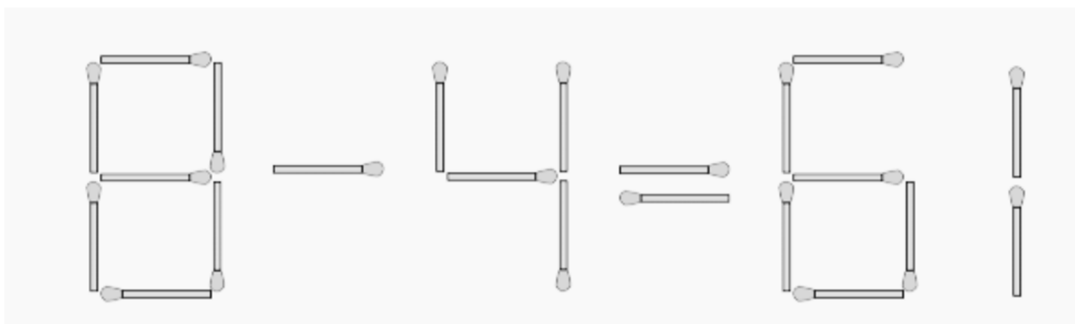

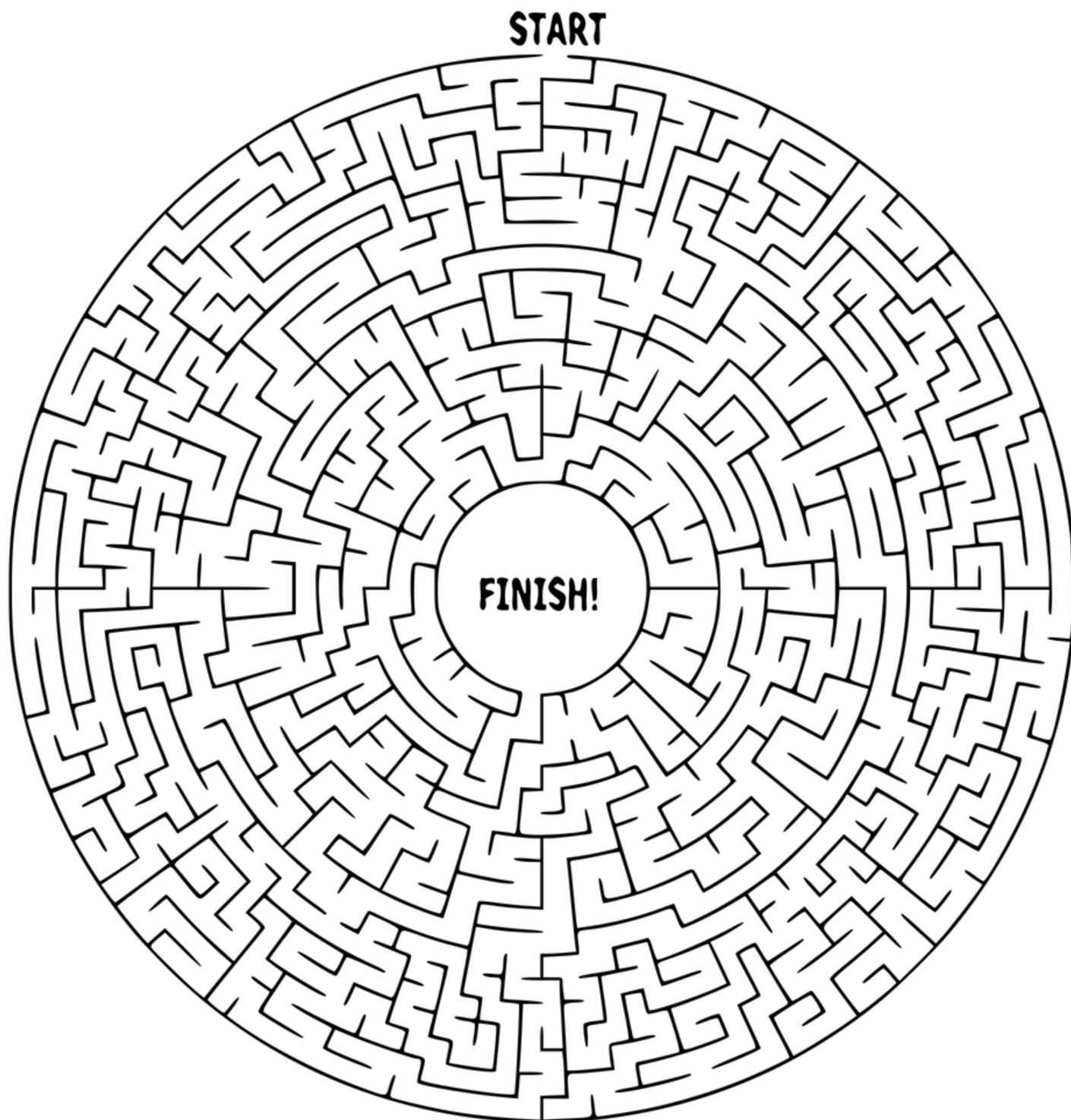

### **What do you like about studying in Adelaide?**

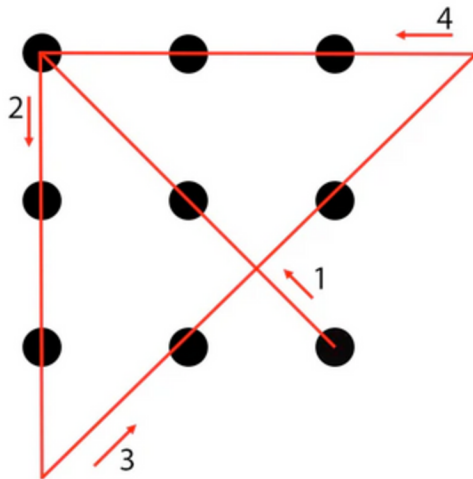
Adelaide's lovely because it resembles the relaxing atmosphere in my hometown, which, to be honest, helped a lot when I first arrived with my homesickness.
