How did you manage to balance academic requirements and personal life?



'High-Rise Harry'

In every issue, we share the story of an individual who immigrated to Australia who went on to achieve business success.

Did you know that the original founder of Meriton was Harry Triguboff. Born in Dalian, China, in 1933 to Russian-Jewish parents. Triguboff has left an inspirational mark on Australia's skyline and as one of Australia's most successful entrepreneurs has left a legacy of resilience, innovation, and an unwavering commitment.

Known as "High-rise Harry," Triguboff's impact on the real estate sector is nothing short of transformative. After migrating to Australia in 1947, he began his career in the construction industry before recognizing the potential of residential property development.
